SUPPLY LIST

- Watercolor Paper - Hot Press (Cold Press will work but smooth surfaced such as Hot Press paper is better) 140 lb., 11x14, 3+ sheets
- Watercolor paints - Students are encouraged to bring what they have, but they will need the following: Paynes Gray, Cadmium Yellow Hue, Viridian Green, Ultramarine Blue, Burnt Sienna
- Brushes - Students can bring whatever brushes they have that will work for watercolor (golden taklon works well), but the following sizes are recommended: Round size 3, size 6, size 8 or 10
- Pencil 2B or 2H
- Eraser
- Smart phone or Ipad for taking some reference pics outside
- One to two printed reference photos of favorite urban/city scenes (optional)
- Instructor will provide all remaining supplies (India ink, pens/nibs, drawing tools, additional paint colors).
