

# WATERCOLOR PORTRAITS WITH LUSIANA HOSTOS

## SUPPLY LIST

- A Watercolor Pad, 140Lb - 300g/m<sup>2</sup> (around \$12)
- A round watercolor brush, size 10 (around \$10)
- Watercolors: there's no need to spend a lot of money; however, you'll need watercolors that are not intended for kids (you'll find them with the words: artist grade, adults, professionals).
  - These are my recommendations:
  - If you prefer a Set: I recommend you to go for the ones that are around \$20 (Windsor&Newton, Arteza).
  - If you prefer Tubes and/or individual pans: You'll need at least the primary colors (yellow, blue, red) or at least 2 of those (around \$3 each).
- An H pencil (around \$2), I recommend a 2H, but any other H pencil you have or even a mechanical pencil would work.
- An eraser
- A plastic palette/watercolor tray (\$0.97)
- A fine line black pen (I recommend gel pen, extra fine tip pen or fineliner pen) (\$1)
- A smartphone or an iPad (if you have one) to create a mood board
- Instructor will provide plastic cups, paper towels, masking tape, and mechanical pencils.
