OIL AND COLD WAX PAINTING WITH KIM PAINTER

DESCRIPTION

In its most basic form, cold wax painting simply means mixing cold wax with oil color then spreading it on a surface. Cold wax lends itself to abstraction beautifully but can be very useful in landscapes, waterscapes or any visual where translucent or luminous qualities are desired. Class begins with a brief overview of basic building blocks in visual art; color, composition, value, form/structure, brushwork & most important - INTENT. We'll use simple photographs (bring your own or use one supplied by the instructor) to help envision a particular place, feeling or emotion. At the end of the day, you'll have a 16x16 art board ready for hanging & multiple paper pieces suitable for framing.
