SUPPLY LIST

- Watercolor Paper - Hot Press (Cold Press will work but smooth surfaced such as Hot Press paper is better) 140 lb, 11x14, 3+ sheets.
- Watercolors - Students are encouraged to bring what they have, but the following are recommended: Paynes Gray, Cadmium Yellow Hue, Viridian Green, Ultramarine Blue, Burnt Sienna, Red - Cadmium, Alizarin Crimson, Naphthol or whatever you prefer.
- Brushes - Students can bring whatever brushes they have that will work for watercolor (golden taklon works well), but the following sizes are recommended: Round size 3, size 6, size 8 or 10.
- Pencil 2B or 2H.
- Eraser.
- Smart phone or tablet for taking some reference pics outside.
- One to two printed reference photos of favorite urban/city scenes (optional)

All remaining supplies (India ink, pens/nibs, drawing tools, additional paint colors) will be supplied by the instructor.
